When you're on the lake, or even on the shore, see if you can spot any of these feathered friends...



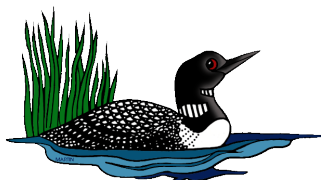

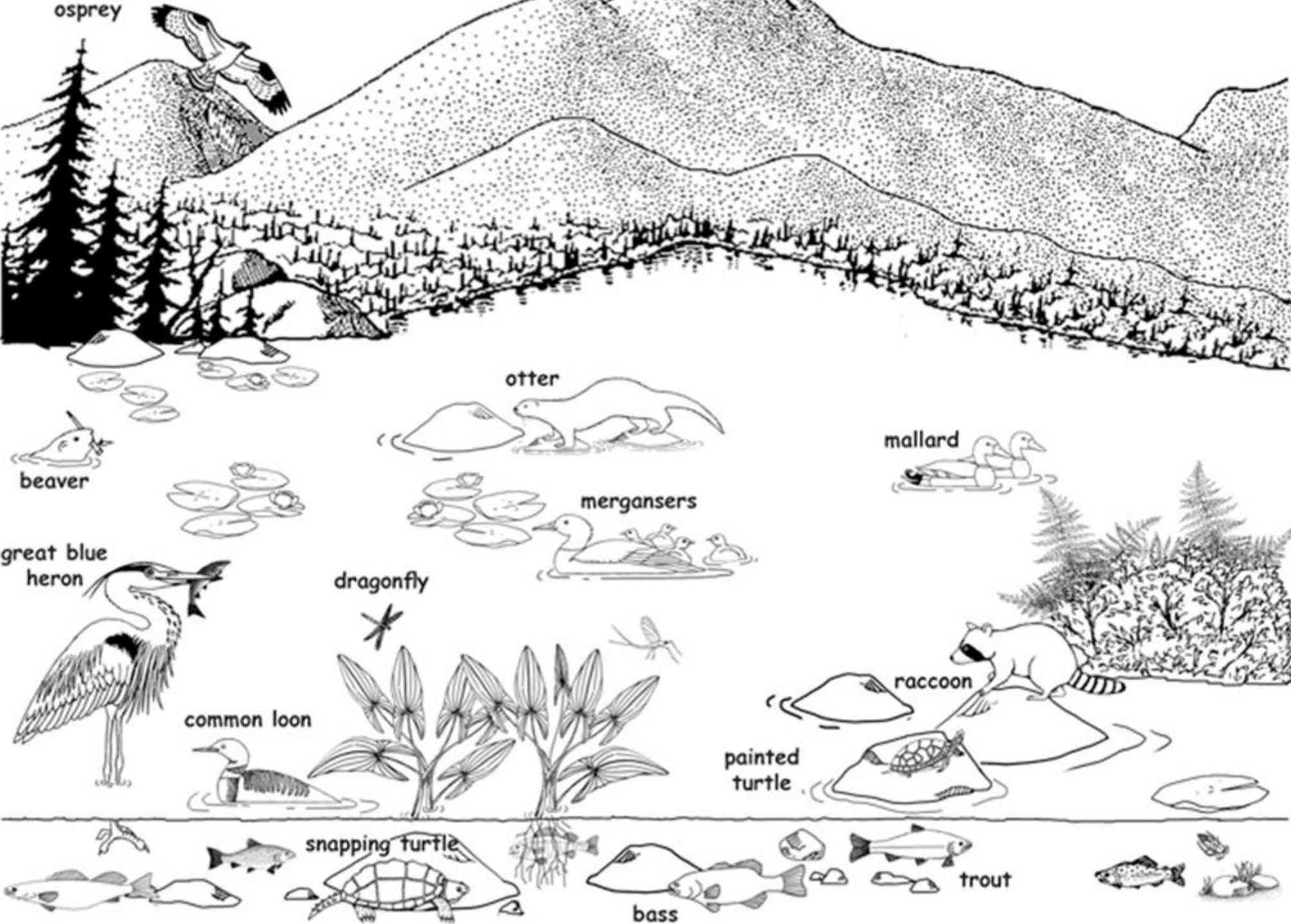
